Materials:


A 16x16 board

5 player pieces, in 4 colors

2 bombs, in 2 colors

2 players on 2 teams

Place the player pieces and bombs like this.



Players on each team take turns. So the order goes:

Team 1, player 1 goes


Team 2, player 1 goes

Team 1, player 2 goes


Team 2, player 2 goes


During your turn, you may move one of your pieces. You may either move it:

## - In any of the 8 directions





- Over another player's piece (you can't move over one of your other pieces). The piece can either be your teammate's piece, or an opponent's piece. If there's a piece that's blocking the jump, you can't move it.





These moves are legal, as the red piece jumps over the orange player's piece





The left move is illegal, because you can't jump over one of your own pieces. The right move is illegal, as the blue piece is blocking the jump.

If you land directly on another player's piece, their piece is removed from the game.

The board has 2 bombs with your color. The goal of the game is to land on one of your team's bombs, and then deliver it to the other end of the board to win. Your team also wins the game if the other team has no pieces remaining.

You can't move another team's bomb. If you capture another team's piece that's carrying a bomb, their bomb returns to its starting position.
